


The 2nd Foreign Startup School in 2025(English)

Invest Seoul offers the 「Foreign Startup School」 for foreigners who wish to start a business in Korea. The class covers basic education for necessary knowledge of entrepreneurship. We look forward to having much interest.

※ Upon completing this OASIS-4 program, participants will receive 10 points toward the selection criteria for Technology Startup Visa (D-8-4).

■ Program Process



■ Recruitment & Application

○ Eligibility

- Foreign (prospective) entrepreneurs residing in Seoul or enrolled at a university in Seoul (approx. 30 participants)
 - ※ Applicants may apply for only one cohort at a time.

○ Application Period: Mar. 18 (Tue) – Apr. 4 (Fri), 2025 (by 17:00 KST)

○ How to Apply

1. Visit the Invest Seoul website (investseoul.org → Click 'Business Application' → Apply)
2. Download the application form and complete it
3. Submit the application form and required documents through the website

○ Required Documents

1. Application form and consent form for the collection, use, and provision of personal information
(*File name: The Foreign Startup School_2nd_Name)
2. Copy of the applicant's alien registration card (front and back) or passport.
*For naturalized citizens: Copy of ID card and naturalization certificate (e.g., basic certificate).

○ Optional Documents

1. Copy of Business Registration Certificate (if applicable)
2. Business introduction or product brochure in Korean/English (PDF format).

■ Selection of Participants

- Participants will be selected based on a comprehensive evaluation of submitted documents, including motivation for application and business plans.
- Final selection results will be individually notified via email and text message. (**Scheduled for April 11).
- Participants who withdraw after selection will be restricted from applying for the Startup School for the next two years.
- If vacancies arise before the program starts, they will be filled based on the priority waiting list.
- Submitted documents will not be returned. Applications containing false or forged documents may result in disqualification.

■ Program Details

- Training Period: April 17 (Thu) – April 30 (Wed), 2025 (10 days in total, 2 hours per session)
- Class Schedule: 19:00 – 21:00 (KST)
- Format: **Online lectures(Zoom)**
- Participants must attend the online sessions in a quiet location without interruptions (e.g., no attending while in transit)
- Training Content: 10 core subjects necessary for starting and registering a business in Korea
- Tuition Fee: Free
- **Completion Requirement: Minimum 80% attendance (16 hours or more)**
